

No. 8303. Equity.

Executrix has duly qualified as such and an exemplification of her said letters is herewith as part herof, marked "Exhibit No. 3."

4. That the said Lewis M. Weidhoff at the time of his death was seized and possessed of certain real estate situated in Frederick City in Frederick County, as follows:

(1) A lot of ground situated on the north side of East Second Street in said City, described in the deed therefor to the said Lewis M. Weidhoff from Andrew Boyd et al. Executors, dated September 24th, 1874, and recorded in Liber T. G. No. 3, folio 524, one of the Land Records of said County, and a certified copy thereof is herewith filed as prayed to be taken as part herof, marked Exhibit No. 3 1/2 and an adjacent lot to the east thereof, described in the deed therefor to the said Lewis M. Weidhoff from James Hopwood and wife, dated April 3, 1876, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 1, folio 302, one of the Land Records of said County, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part herof, marked "Exhibit No. 4."

(2) A lot of ground situated on the north side of West Patrick Street in said City, described in the deed therefor to the said Lewis M. Weidhoff from Louis Nidebraud, dated April 12, 1886, and recorded in Liber N. S. F. No. 1, folio 362, one of said Land Records, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as prayed to be taken as part herof, marked "Exhibit No. 5."

(3) A lot of ground situated on the west side of South Tully Street in said City, described in the deed therefor to the said Lewis M. Weidhoff from Caroline Weidhoff, dated April 14, 1875, and recorded in Liber T. G. No. 3, folio 524, one of said Land Records, a certified copy whereof is filed as part herof, marked "Exhibit No. 6."

(4) A lot of ground situated in the rear of the above mentioned lot on the west side of South Tully Street, described in the deed therefor to the said Lewis M. Weidhoff from William N. Fongue, dated January 29, 1876, and recorded in Liber A. F. No. 1, folio 333, one of said Land Records, a certified copy whereof is herewith filed as part herof, marked "Exhibit No. 7."

5. That the said Lewis M. Weidhoff in his life-time executed and delivered a certain mortgage in which his said wife, Eliza F. Weidhoff, joined, conveying the first, third and fourth lots of ground heretofore mentioned to Charles F. Long, Trustee, in no. 4887, Equity in this Court, and guardian of Roger S. Long, and Arthur E. Long,
