to secure the payment of an indebtedness of Four Thousand and Two Hundred Dollars (\$4,200), and interest in said mortgage up to the extent of \$1000- each have been assigned to the said Roger S. and Arthur E. Long, which said mortgage is dated September 14, 1903, and each said Assignment is recorded in Liber D. C. N. No. 18, folio 613, one of the Land Records of said County, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed and prayed to be taken as part hereof, marked "Exhibit No. 8" and the said mortgage remains unpaid and outstanding.

6. That the said Lewis M. Kirdorff in his lifetime did also execute and deliver a certain mortgage in which his said wife, Eliza J. Kirdorff, joined, conveying the second lot of ground heretofore mentioned, situated on West Patrick Patrick Street in said City, to John E. Price, together with other property subsequently conveyed away in the lifetime of the said Lewis M. Kirdorff, to secure the payment of an indebtedness of Three Thousand and Five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500), which said mortgage is dated January 27, 1898, and is recorded in Liber D. C. N. No. 2, folio 157, one of said Land Records, a Certified Copy whereof is herewith filed as part hereof, marked "Exhibit No. 9, and the said mortgage remains due and unpaid, as your matrix understands, to the extent of about Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000).

7. That the said Lewis M. Kirdorff, deceased, did not have personal estate sufficient to pay his debts and Costs of Administration.

8. That the said Eliza J. Kirdorff, John E. Price and Charles F. Long, Trustee and Guardian as aforesaid, are all adults and reside in Frederick County, and the said Roger S. Long and Arthur E. Long are adults, and reside in Baltimore City, Maryland.

Wherefore your matrix prays for the following relief:-

(1.) That a decree may be passed by your Honorable Court, for the sale of the said real estate of the said Lewis M. Kirdorff, deceased, or so much thereof as may be necessary, and for the application of the net proceeds thereof to the payment of the debts of the said deceased.

(2.) That your matrix may have all such other and further relief as the case may require.
