This Deed, made this 29th day of January
 in the year Eighteen Hundred and Seventy Six by me William
 Brugel of Frederick County in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth
 that in Consideration of the sum of two hundred & ten dollars
 I the said William Brugel do grant in fee Simple
 unto Lewis W. Nixdorff of said County, and state that
 lot or parcel of Ground being part of a lot or parcel
 of ground which was conveyed to the said William
 Brugel by the Surviving Children and Heirs at law
 of Henrietta Stone late of said County, dec'd by deed
 bearing date the fourteenth day of December 1875,
 and recorded in Liber T. D. No. 4, folio 263.
