J. Flook respectfully shew unto your Honorable Court:-

First: Jacob Shank, late of Frederick County, but now
deceased, by his deed duly executed and acknowledged and
recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County, bearing
date the 4th day of May, A. D., 1905, did convey unto the
Defendants, Otha J. Shank and Susan F. Haupt, and
to the Plaintiffs, Emma A. Kogale and Fannie L. M. Keller,
and to Lavinia A. S. Flook, the following described pieces or
