10. Your petitioners deem it indispensable to the protection of the rights of said last named child and two grandchildren that the said purchase money of Eight Thousand Dollars be collected with interest and entrusted by the Administrators under the order of the orphan's court for Frederick County, for the benefit of all the children of said deceased and the grand children of any deceased child or children of him.

11. That your petitioners insist and claim that the said property is first liable for the payment of the Vendor's lien for the unpaid purchase money of Eight Thousand Dollars and interest, above mentioned, and before the sale of the said lands under a decree for the purposes of partition among the grantees in said deed. Your petitioners respectfully say that the right of the administrators to enforce the said lien against said lands should be heard and determined by your Honorable Court.

Your petitioners therefore pray your Honors.

(1) That said decree of December 1-1906, passed by your Honorable Court in this cause, be vacated, annulled and set aside, and

(2) That the said trustees Emory L. Keokuty and Lloyd M. Hoyle, be restrained from proceeding further under said decree and from making sale of said real estate under said decree, until the further order of this Court, and

(3) That they may have such other and further relief as the nature of their case may require.
