in their said petition, in the way of having the said decree in these proceedings restrained, because the said Vendor's lien existing and enforceable would be equally or available as against the said real estate itself; the said sale so decreed, and the proceedings for the enforcement of said alleged Vendor's lien, all being under the Authority or Control of your Honorable Court; and your Honorable Court; and your Petitioners and respondents are willing that the proceeds of said sale of said real estate, so decreed to be sold, shall be held under the order of this Court to abide the determination of the proceedings for the enforcement of said alleged Vendor's lien.

2nd. That your Petitioners know of prospective purchasers who are in the market for the real estate and who desire to bid on the property in question, and that the present, and on that account and for other reasons is the most opportune time for offering said real estate for sale, and that it is to the interest and advantage of all the parties concerned that said property should be sold as advertised under the decree in these proceedings, and upon the date mentioned in said advertisement, to-wit: December 29, 1906, and that a postponement of said sale to await the determination of said Vendor's lien proceedings, would accomplish no good results to any of the parties in the above entitled cause who are the owners in fee of said real estate.

Wherefore, your petitioners pray that the order of your Honorable Court passed December 22, 1906, upon the petition of said Administrators, be rescinded, and that your Petitioners as trustees appointed by the decree of your Honorable Court, may be authorized to proceed with said sale as advertised, and that the said sale be made free of the alleged Vendor's lien, and that the proceeds of sale be held subject to the order of the Court to abide the determination of the said Vendor's lien proceedings; and that your petitioners may have such other and further relief as their case may require.
