To the Honorable the Judge of said Court:-
The Petition and Report of Sales of Edward J. Henderson, Mortgagee of Alma Gertrude Baker and Charles A. Baker, her husband, respectfully shew:

1st. That on the eleventh day of April in the year nineteen hundred and seven a certain Alma Gertrude Baker and together with her husband Charles A. Baker, by their deed of Mortgage duly executed, acknowledged and recorded, conveyed certain real estate situated in Frederick County, Maryland, to your Petitioner to secure the payment of the Mortgage debt of Twelve hundred dollars therein mentioned, which deed of Mortgage contained a proviso that if default should be made in the payment of the Mortgage debt or in the payment of the interest thereon, then it should be lawful for said Edward J.
