

No. 8337. Equity.

Containing 4 acres of land more or less. Also at and for the sum of \$200 = all that parcel of land purchased by one of Isaac Poppfuburger Trustee of Daniel Poppfuburger. Situated on the North or North East side of the Old Hagerstown Road, and adjoining the lands of Jacob Tombs & John Belsinger and is contained with the following meter and bounds. Course and distances to wit: Beginning at a stone planted on the West side of the aforesaid "Old Hagerstown Road" and near the end of a stone wall and running thence N. 52 degrees West. 26-7/10 perches to a stone in said "Old Road"; thence leaving said road North 53 1/4 degrees East (great local attraction) 38 8/10 perches to a stone; North 25 degrees (along the line of Belsinger's land) 15 perches to a stone on the line dividing the lands thereby conveyed and the lands belonging to Jacob Tombs, thence along the lands of said "Tombs" South 16 degrees East 8 1/2 perches into the aforesaid Old Hagerstown Road, and with it North 78 degrees West 30 perches North 53 1/2 degrees West 21 3/4 perches, to the place of Beginning.
