The Bill further states that the Plaintiff, Laura E. Lutterman is 32 years of age, has been married 26 years and has had two children born to her and that it would be to the benefit and advantage of all the parties concerned to have said real estate sold, and the proceeds arising therefrom invested or distributed as the Court may deem. The Bill for a decree for the sale of said real estate and for general relief; for summons against the resident defendants and an order of publication against the defendants who are non-residents of Maryland.
