1st. House and Lot in Myeraville located on the east side, Main St, at the north end of town.

2nd. The farm and fields on the east of the old Hogestown road, adjoining the road to Church Hill and the U. B. Church property and Outing.

3rd. The Bottom field lying east of Myeraville on the road from Myeraville to Ellerton, containing about 4 acres.

4th. Mountain lot located on the road leading from Church Hill to Hoefville near the Woodland School House and all four tracts or parcels are located in Frederick County, Maryland. As to value of house and lot not less than four thousand dollars, as to field located near the U. B. Church not less than eight thousand dollars as to bottom field on the Ellerton road, not less than five thousand dollars, as to mountain lot not less than forty dollars for either lot or parcel of land.
