(5) That the only source from which sufficient
funds can be raised for the support and
Maintenance of Said Now Coupon notes and
to defray the Costs and expenses of this case
and debt is by the sale of his interest in Said
real estate.

(6) That your Petitioner has an offer from Clara
V. Meier and Cora M. Powell of the sum of Two
hundred and fifty dollars Cash for the interest
of Said Ignatius Thompson in Said real estate.

Therefore your Petitioner prays your Honorable
Court to pass an order directing him to sell and
convey the aforesaid interest of the Ignatius Thompson
unto the Said Clara V. Meier and Cora M. Powell
for the sum of Two hundred and fifty dollars Cash
for the purposes set forth in this petition. And for
for such further relief as his case may require.
