

## No. 8351. Equity.

To the Honorable, the Judge of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity.

Your Orator, William H. Quinn, complaining Supp-  
First.

That your Orator is a resident of Frederick County, Maryland, and an adult.
