

## No. 8549, Equity.

Investments of Alexander Garley Jr. Trustee of Lillie Baugher" and your Petitioner also files herewith a statement of the nature, location, and income per year of the present investments. He has made as Surviving Trustee of Lillie Baugher, which statement is marked "Exhibit List of Ground Rents, held by Alexander Garley Jr. Trustee of Lillie Baugher" both of which said Exhibits are made a part hereof and prayed to be taken as part of this Petition.

That all of the investments so made and at present held by your Petitioner as such Surviving Trustee, are in the judgment of your Petitioner safe and secure, and yield a total annual income of about \$500.

That Your Petitioner on the 4th day of December 1888, filed a Petition in the Circuit Court for Frederick County, in a Cause known as No. 5492, Equity, and styled "Alexander Garley Jr. Surviving Trustee under the Will of Joseph Baugher, for Joseph Baugher on Petition" in which said Cause a complete statement of the receipts and investments of your Petitioner as said last named Trustee was filed, and your Petitioner was of the opinion and believed that in said Cause No. 5492, Equity, he had asked your Honorable Court to assume jurisdiction of the trust estate of your Petitioner as Trustee of Lillie Baugher, but he is now informed that the trust estate of the said Lillie Baugher was not included in said Cause, No. 5492, Equity.

That your Petitioner, in the execution and Administration of the said trust, desires the aid and assistance and protection of your Honorable Court, and now reports the investments and protection of your Honorable Court, and now reports the investments made at the time he entered upon his duties as said Trustee, and the present investments of said estate, for the sanction and approval of your Honorable Court, and prays that your Honor may assume jurisdiction of said Trust Estate and pass an order of your Honorable Court, approving and ratifying the investments so made, by your Petitioner, and that he may have such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of his case may require.
