(C) An adult son June A. Johnson whose wife's name is Inez Johnson, both being non-residents of the State of Maryland and residing in Boston.

(D) An adult son, Lou Emanuel Johnson, who is a non-resident of the State of Maryland and resides at Alleghany City, State of Pennsylvania.

(E) An adult daughter Vera Gails whose husband's name is John Gails both non-residents of the State of Maryland and residing at New Brighton State of Pennsylvania.

(F) An infant daughter Maggie Johnson, aged about 19 years, who is unmarried, a non-resident and resides at New Brighton State of Pennsylvania.

(G) An infant daughter Glover Johnson, aged 17 years, unmarried and residing in Frederick County, Maryland.

(H) An infant son, Frederick Johnson, aged 14 years, unmarried, a non-resident, and residing at New Brighton, State of Pennsylvania.

3rd. That the real estate above described of which the said John Wesley Johnson died seized and possessed descended to and vested in the parties aforesaid as tenants in common, and that the said real estate is not susceptible of partition or division amongst the parties entitled thereto without great loss, damage and injury to them, and it would be to the best interest and advantage of all the parties concerned and especially of the infant heirs to have the said real estate sold under a decree of this Honorable Court and the proceeds divided amongst, or invested for the benefit of the parties entitled thereto according to their respective interests and rights.

To the end therefore

(1st) That a decree may be passed for the sale of the Real estate of which the said John Wesley Johnson died seized and possessed and mentioned and described in paragraph 1: of this Bill of Complaint in Exhibit A. Filed herewith.

(2nd) That the proceeds arising from said sale may be distributed amongst the parties entitled thereto according to their respective interests and rights, the share of said infants to be invested for their benefit as by law provided.

(3rd.) That your Complainants may have such other and your Orators the order of Publication directed to the said non-resident defendants: William Johnson
