The object of a Petition filed by Charles W. Schildner in the above  
 entitled Cause, is to procure the payment of a claim  
 due and owing the said Charles W. Schildner by John  
 Wesley Johnson at the time of his death, out of the pro-  
 ceeds of the sale of the real estate mentioned and  
 described and prayed to be sold in the above entitled

The petition of Charles W. Schildner states in  
 substance, that Lewis Walker and Mollie Walker, his wife,  
 of Frederick County, Maryland, have filed a Bill in this  
 Court, against William Johnson et al, (it being this Cause
