The Petition of Charles W. Schiltmeck a Creditor in  
said cause and Exhibit No. 1, thereto, and all the other  
proceedings and testimony therein having by the Court been  
read and considered, and a decree for costs,  
having been regularly passed by the Court on said  
petition against all the parties to said cause  
on the 1st day of February 1903, and more than  
30th days having elapsed since the passage of  
said decree and it appearing from the proceedings  
in said cause that the cause is now ready  
to be referred to the Auditor to state an account.

It is therefore this 29th day of April 1903, by the  
Circuit Court for Indiana County, sitting as a Court of  
Equity and by the authority thereof, ordered, adjudged and  
decreed that the claim of the Creditor Charles W. Schiltmeck,  
against William Johnson, decedent be and the  
same is hereby ordered to be paid out of the proceeds  
of the property sold in these proceedings and that  
the Auditor is hereby directed to audit said claim of  
\$125.70, to said Charles W. Schiltmeck or so much thereof as  
may be left after the payment of all the costs, expenses  
Commission of Trustee and Counsel for incidents to said sale.
