My sister-in-law is now nearly 87 years of age and can scarcely walk any more and has no means whatever to support her, and inasmuch as my husband promised to pay her, I have already testified, I think she ought to be paid. These services were rendered to my husband at his request, and I heard him say on numerous occasions that his sister should be paid for these services.

Q. What personal estate, if any, did your husband leave at the time of his death?

A. He left some personal property which was sold but which didn't amount to a great deal and was hardly sufficient to pay the funeral expenses.

Q. Look at Exhibit No. 2, now shown and state what it is?

A. I look at Exhibit No. 2 shown me and it is a Certified Copy of my husband's will.

Q. By the provisions of this will your husband gave and devised unto you his wife all his property, real, and personal and mixed, during your life, and after your death he devised the same to be distributed among his children and his sister Sarah Alexander, share and share alike, each share to be paid to his children except the share devised and bequeathed to his daughter, Ella Flook, wife of Martin Flook, and to his son, Peter Alexander, whose respective shares he devised should be invested until their children become of age and then the same to be paid to the children of the said Ella Flook and Peter Alexander. Please tell all you know about these devisees or legatees?

A. As I have already said my husband's sister, Sarah Alexander, is living with my daughter, Alberta Poffinberger, in Myersville. My husband at the time of his death left also the following children who are still living, to-wit: - Alberta Poffinberger, a daughter, with whom I live at Myersville, George Alexander, a son, Tilghman Alexander, a son, who are adults and who reside near Sabillasville, in Frederick County, Maryland, my daughter, Ella Flook resides in Frederick County, Maryland, and she has the following children: - Nora M. Flook, Mary G.
