

No. 8532, Equity.

For Frederick County, Maryland, all of which will more fully appear in your Honorable Court, by reference to Exhibit No. 1, filed herewith, and which together with all other exhibits is prayed to be taken and considered as a part hereof.

2nd. That by the terms and conditions of the first Codicil to Said will, it was provided that the sum of \$1500.00 should be set apart for the purpose of the Said Caroline Fox, to purchase a home to that amount, which Said home was to be used by her for and during the term of her natural life.

3rd. That in pursuance of Said provision, the said sum of \$1500.00 was received by the Said Caroline Fox in her lifetime, and was by her, together with a small amount of her own money, (the exact amount of which has not as yet been ascertained by your orators) invested in a home which she purchased from Thaddeus W. Stein, and wife, which said property is described in a deed to the Said Caroline Fox, a certified copy of said deed being filed herewith, marked Exhibit No. 2, 4th. That on the 12th. day of February A. D. 1910, the Said Caroline Fox, died, and since her death to wit:— On the 21st day of February 1910, letters of Administration, A. C. No. C. J. A, upon the estate of Ernest A. C. Fox, deceased, were granted unto two of your orators, namely, Louis W. Fox, and Henry H. C. Fox, as fully appears by an exemplification of said letters, marked Exhibit No. 3, and filed herewith as part hereof.

5th. That the said last will, and the first Codicil thereto Ernest A. C. Fox, deceased, provided, that upon the death of his widow the said sum of \$1500.00 should be sold by his Administrators, A. C. No. C. J. A, and the proceeds arising from the said sale should be distributed to the children as named in said last will and testament of Ernest A. C. Fox, deceased, as provided by said Exhibit No. 1, which by reference thereto will more fully appear to your Honorable Court.

6th. That owing to the fact that certain monies of the said Caroline Fox, were invested in said real estate together with the said trust fund of \$1500.00 giving certain parties, other than those named in the said last will and testament of Ernest A. C. Fox, an interest in said real estate such as was not contemplated by him in said will, and which said interest, the Administrators aforesaid entertained doubts as to their
