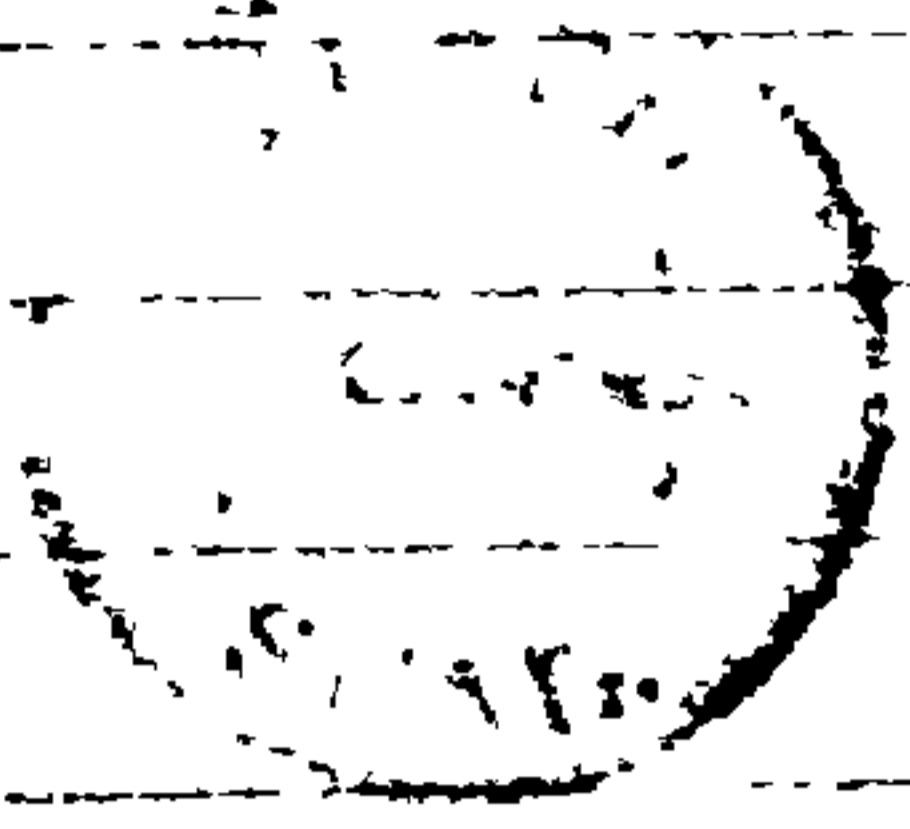

This Deed, made this Twenty eighth day of February in the year eighteen hundred and eighty two.

Witnesseth that I Michael H. Foub, Executor of the last Will of Hanson Marlow, late of Frederick County, deceased under a power in Said Will contained in consideration of the sum of two hundred and Twenty dollars, have bargained and sold, and do hereby grant to William S. Foub, all the following described land containing Eleven acres of land more or less situated in Washington County, State of Maryland about two miles from Harroton and on the road leading from Harroton to Brownville and being the same land described in the deed from Thomas Johnson Trustee to Said Hanson Marlow dated on the thirteenth day of October eighteen hundred and fifty eight and recorded in Liber L. M. no. 13. folio 698 & 699 one of the Land Records of Washington County, Maryland.

Beginning for Said lot of ground at the end of ten and four tenths perches on the West line of Lot No. twenty three referred to in the aforesaid deed, and running thence with the outlines thereof, the following Courses by, North thirties and three quarter degrees East eleven and six tenths perches, North twenty degrees East nine and sixty five hundredth perches to the beginning of Said Lot No. 23. Still with the outlines, South Sixty nine and a half degrees, East thirteon perches to a stone, South Seventy four degrees, East Seventy six perches, South twenty four degrees West twenty one and forty five hundredth perches, thence by a divisional line North Seventy four and a half degrees, West to the Beginning, containing Eleven acres of land more or less, & being the same lot of ground, sold by Said Executor, to Said William S. Foub at public Sale on the 15 day of November 1881, and reported Said Sale to the Orphans Court of Frederick County, Maryland on the 31st day of January
