12th.

Q Look at the paper herewith handed you and state what it is?

13th.

Q Does this receipt set forth the date the money was received by you?

Ans.

It does.

14th.

Q After you received the money for the mortgage, what did you do with the mortgage?

Ans.

I don't recollect about that. I think I released it. It was done at the Court House on the record.

15th.

Q What was done with the mortgage itself and the mortgage note?

Ans.

The mortgage itself, I don't know what was done with that. It may be among the my Father's papers. The note was given to Mrs. Cooley, when she paid it.

16th.

Q At the time Mrs. Cooley paid the mortgage off, was there any interest due on it?

Ans.

Yes Sir - I think one years interest was due \$200⁰⁰

17th.

Q Can you tell by looking at your account in the official books what interest was paid you on this mortgage?

Ans.

Yes, Sir I can.

18th.

Q Did Mrs. Cooley pay you this interest at the time she paid the mortgage?

Ans.

Yes, Sir.
