Daniel O'Connell now which may be found upon Record in the Clerk's Office of the Co. of Frederick M. D. and running East with the aforesaid Tract Two Hundred and Ten feet thence South one Hundred & fifty feet thence East Two Hundred & Ten feet to intersect the line of the original Tract of which this is a part thence North with said original line to the place of beginning containing One Acre More or less in fee Simple
