The above Cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered and all the parties to the Cause being answered to the Bill of Complaints and consented to the passage of a decree as prayed. It is thereupon, this 19th day of July in the year nineteen hundred and seven by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed, that the land and premises in due proceedings be sold or so much thereof as may be necessary for the payment of the debts, funeral expenses of Catherine Thomas, deceased and that Emory L.
