Petition

To the Honorable, the Judge of  
the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a  
Court of Equity:

The Petition of Martin A. Leastle, of Frederick  
County, in the State of Maryland, respectfully repre-  
sents unto your Honor:-

1st. That on the 22nd day of July, in the  
year 1907, a certain Blantha O. Leastle, of said  
County, and State, executed unto your petitioner  
a deed of trust conveying unto your petitioner  
all of her property upon the trusts set forth in  
said deed, all of which will fully appear by  
reference to said deed of trust which is herewith  
filed marked Exhibit No. 1, which it is prayed  
may be taken and considered as a part of  
this petition.

2nd. That your petitioner has accepted said  
trust and has filed his duly approved bond in  
the Clerk's Office of your Honorable Court conditioned  
for the faithful discharge of the trust reposed in  
him.

3rd. That it is desirable that your Honorable  
Court, should take cognizance of said trust and  
to direct your trustee in the management of said  
trust estate.

4th. Your Trustee advertised the real property
