of the expenses incident to the administration of the trusts hereby created, should not, in the judgment of the said trustee, be sufficient to maintain and support me, the said Blancha O. Carter, then the said trustee is hereby authorized to pay me such sum <sup>of</sup> of the corpus of the said trust estate hereby created, which in addition to the income arising from said investments, shall, in the judgment of my said trustee, be sufficient to properly maintain and support me, the receipt of me the said Blancha O. Carter to be a sufficient discharge to said trustee for the payments herein authorized.

3rd. And this deed further Witness: - That should the said Blancha O. Carter desire at any time to again take charge of the estate hereby conveyed and should the said trustee deem it advisable and for her best interests that she should again take charge of and assume the management of said trust estate, then and in that event only the said trustee is hereby authorized to re-convey unto the said Blancha O. Carter the said trust estate in his hands hereby created, or so much thereof as may still be remaining in his hands, and to take his receipt shall be a sufficient discharge to the said trustee in the payment and transfer of the said trust estate hereby created.

4th. And this deed further Witness: - That at the death of the said Blancha O. Carter the said trust estate hereby created, or so much thereof, as may still be remaining in the hands of the said trustee shall be paid to the personal representatives of the said Blancha O. Carter.

And the said Blancha O. Carter for the purpose aforesaid does hereby constitute and appoint Martin H. Carter her true and lawful attorney to demand, sue for and receive of and from all and every person or persons, all the property of every kind and description, debts, or sums of money due belonging or owing to the said Blancha O. Carter, and to execute due acquittances of the same, and to compound for any doubtful debts, and further to do all other acts required to be done in the premises as fully and effectually as she the said Blancha O. Carter might or could have done if these presents had not been executed.
