Marked B on the East Side of said line and on the South End of a good line leaving said line still with the same back meeting the same with 61° East $21\frac{1}{2}$ per. north 56° East $88\frac{1}{2}$ perches to the place of beginning containing 290. a. 3 a. 04 per. also part of a track of land called True Friendship being the same land deeded by Basil Wood to Frederick Eichelberger by deed dated 11th of May 1877. Beginning at a stone formerly placed at the end of the 3rd line of True Friendship, it being also the beginning of Basil Wood and wife parcel of land conveyed by Christian Rudy to James Leampool and running thence connecting the lines S 63° E. 110 perches to a stone on South side of a "Vickory Stump" N. 55° E. $7\frac{1}{10}$ perches to a stone at the end of $35\frac{1}{10}$ perches to the 2nd line of a track called "Huber Tract" and with said track connecting the same S 63° E. $4\frac{1}{10}$ perches to a stone at the end of said line still N. 55° E. 28 perches N. 42° East $28\frac{1}{10}$ perches to intersect Basil Wood's land at the end of 9 perches on the 4th line thereof N. 85° E. 15 perches to the end of said 4th line then with the outlines thereof connecting the same S. 9° W. 26 perches to a stone near the East Margin of Ovington horsees S. 67° W. 48 perches to a stone on the North bank of Monocacy.
