At the request of John Potyaku the following deed was recorded June 27th 1863.

This deed made this 13th day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty three by Elias Strise and Mary Ann Strise his wife. Witnesseth that for in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars the said Elias Strise & wife doth grant unto John Potyaku of Frederick County, Maryland the following tract of Mountain land called "The Salt Trough Long enough" Beginning for the same at the end of the 7th line of the original and thence S. 13 1/4 degrees W. 38 1/2 perches S. 33 1/4. 45 perches thence with a direct line to intersect the 8th line at the end of 133 perches and with it N. 38 degrees E. 48 perches N. 81 degrees E. 44 perches to the beginning containing 20 acres in being the same tract conveyed by Nathl Engler & others to Elias Strise by deed bearing date 28th day of March 1854 and recorded in Liber B. G. F. No. 9. folio 408. one of the Land Records of Frederick County, and also doth grant the following parcel of land, Beginning for the same at a stone placed at the end of the 14th line of the said Potyaku's land on which he now resides and running thence S. 62 degrees East 35 1/2 perches to a stone placed S. 54 1/2 degrees W. 7 1/10 perches to a stone N. 62 degrees W. 30 1/2 perches to corner of fence thence to the beginning containing 1. 1/2 2. R. & 9 perches. as witness our hands and seals.

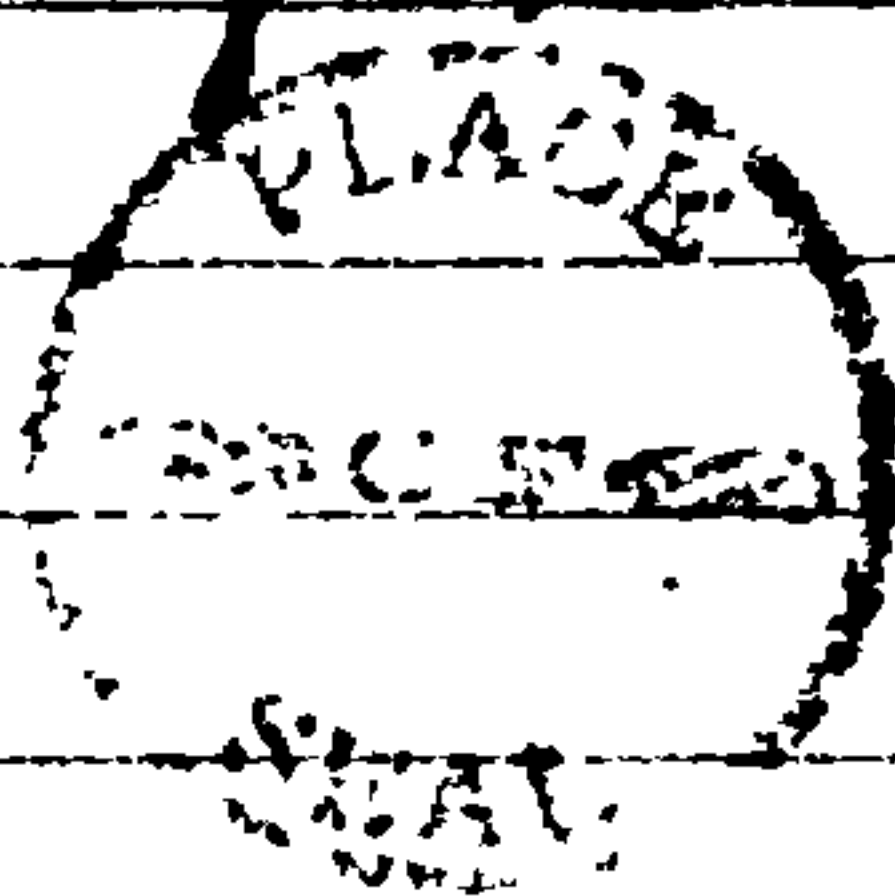
