will pay being 104 acres and 64 acres formerly owned by Benjamin Walke and described in #3803 Equity in your Honorable Court and also was seized of other real estate which however he sold during his lifetime by written contract and for which the purchasers are entitled to conveyances from his Administrator on payment of all the purchase money.

4. That the lands of which said George W. Fryor died seized and possessed and which were not sold by him in his lifetime cannot be divided without loss and injury to the parties interested and it will be for the benefit of all the parties that the same be sold and the proceeds divided among the parties according to their respective rights.

The plaintiffs pray for the following relief.

1. That a decree may be passed for the sale of the said real estate not sold by said George W. Fryor in his life time and the proceeds of sale be divided among the parties interested according to their respective rights.

2. For all such further and other relief as they may be entitled to and plaintiffs pray for the following process.

1. For the writ of Subpoena directed to the Said Catherine Missouri Walke and John Mc Wilkerson her husband, Anna Alice Milbaugh and Frank Milbaugh her husband and Nettie Anderson and Albert Anderson her husband adult defendants residing in Frederick County and Mary E. Nise and adult defendant residing in Washington County, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in this Court on some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.

2. For an order publication giving notice to Melvin A. Fryor and Annie Fryor his wife and Ella M. Fryor and Florence Fryor his wife who are adults, now and then defendants of the substance and object of this bill and warning them to appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before some certain day to be therein named to answer the premises and show cause if any they have why a decree should not pass as prayed and as in duty ve.
