Your Orators Complaining Say:—

1. That Joseph B. Brown late of Frederick County, died  
on or about February, A. D. 1906, intestate, leaving surviving  
a widow Lianna Brown who is an adult over  
twenty one year of age and resides in Frederick  
County, State of Maryland, and the following chil-  
dren and heirs at law, viz:—

(A) A daughter Martha Brown who is married  
to John J. Kortbaugh, both of whom are adults  
over twenty one year of age and both reside at  
Cheverville in Washington County, State of Maryland.

(B) A son Wilford Brown whose wife's name is Annie  
Brown both of whom are adults over twenty one year  
of age and reside at Keder in Miami County, State of Ohio.

(C) A son Charles H. Brown whose wife's name is Nettie  
J. Brown, both of whom are adults over twenty one year  
of age and both reside at Cheverville in Washington County  
State of Maryland;

(D) A son Wilford Brown whose wife's name is Annie  
Brown both of whom are adults over twenty one year  
of age and reside at Keder in Miami County, State  
of Ohio.

(E) A son Charles H. Brown whose wife's name is Nettie  
J. Brown, both of whom are adults over twenty one year  
of age and reside in Frederick County, State of  
Maryland and are plaintiffs in this case.

(F) A daughter Effie Brown, who is married to John  
M. Lutz, both of whom are adults over twenty one  
years of age and reside Waynesboro in Franklin  
County, State of Pennsylvania.

(G) A daughter Mary W. Brown who is married to Fred-  
erick W. Tidemore both of whom are adults over twenty one
