This deed made this twenty fifth day of May in the year one thousand eight hundred and ninety five by Joseph B. Brown and Liana Brown his wife of Frederick County, State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of some thousand one hundred dollars the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged the said Joseph B. Brown and Liana Brown do grant unto Charles H. Brown of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, all the following described tract or parcel of land lying and being situate in Frederick State of Maryland, beginning for said tract to be hereby conveyed at stone planted for corner on line of Josiah Wickhede's land, said corner being on West Side of Public Road leading from Glenfield Station.
