This deed made this 24th day of May in the year of our Lord one
 thousand eight hundred and Ninety nine by Albrok Louty of Frederick
 County, and State of Maryland, Witnesseth, that the said Albrok Louty for
 the consideration of Twenty five Dollars, doth give grant bargain and sell
 unto Charles A. Epler, Cyrus Louty, James F. William George de Ambrose and
 John Louty, Trustees and their successors in office, for the use of the
 United Brethren in Church and for all other orthodox Ministers to
 preach the Gospel, whom now occupied by said United Brethren in Church, with
 the Consent of said Trustees, from all the following described Lot of Land,
 as a site for a Church to be named and designated as Smithfield. P. B.
 Church, Beginning at a Stone placed at the end of a line 3.4 perches East
 of a Bridge near Smithfield School House, running in path with Public
 road South 20 degrees East 17. perches to Yellow Tree on North East bank of
 Oxen Creek thence South 60 1/2 degrees East 1.8 perches thence North 45 1/2 degrees
 East 5.6 perches crossing public road, thence with said road North 52 degrees
 7.2 perches thence North 48 1/2 degrees East 7.6 perches to line of Station Maryland
 Rail road and with said line 9.6 perches thence South 57 1/2 degrees West
 6 perches to fence of beginning containing 5/8 of an acre of land more or less
 To have and to hold the above property as a site for a Church and Cemetery, and
 for no other purpose. This deed shall not become invalid in case of any failure
 to elect a Succession of Trustees.
