

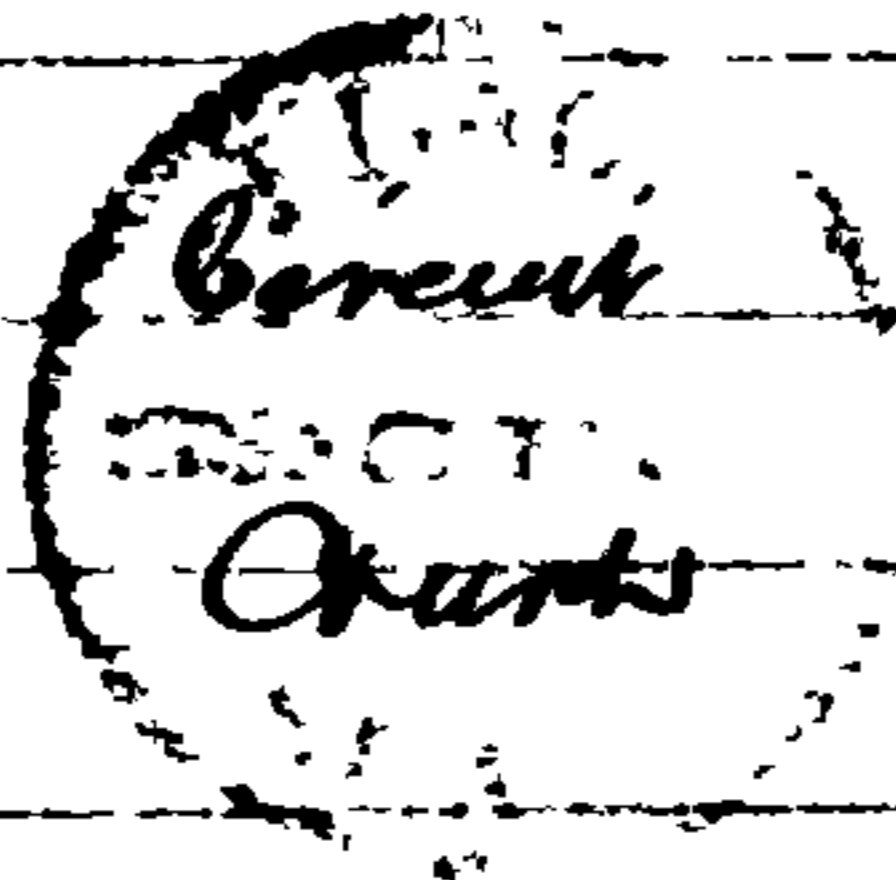

Brown and Maria Brown his wife, for and Consideration of twenty dollars to them in hand paid, by the said David Bukman, the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge, have bargained, granted, sold, released, released and confirmed and by their presents do bargain, grant, sell, release, release and confirm unto the said David Bukman his heirs and assigns, all that tract or parcel of land Situate in Frederick County, Maryland, and Confined within the following metes and bounds, beginning for the same with a corner of E. Stiers line and running South with his line 22 rods to a stone pile, thence East ten rods to a stone pile in David Bukman's
