Eyer, Surviving executor of the last will of David Harbaugh, late of Frederick County, Maryland deceased. Witnesseth that whereas by a provision contained in said will the said testator did authorize and empower his executors named in said will to sell all of his real estate, and whereas Hamilton Harbaugh one of said executors, did before, executing the trust reposed in him by said will as one of the executors aforesaid, and whereas upon application in person of Charles A. Eyer the Surviving Executor of said will, the Orphans Court of Frederick County, by its order dated on the fifth day of April 1881, did order the said Charles A. Eyer Surviving executor of the last will of said David
