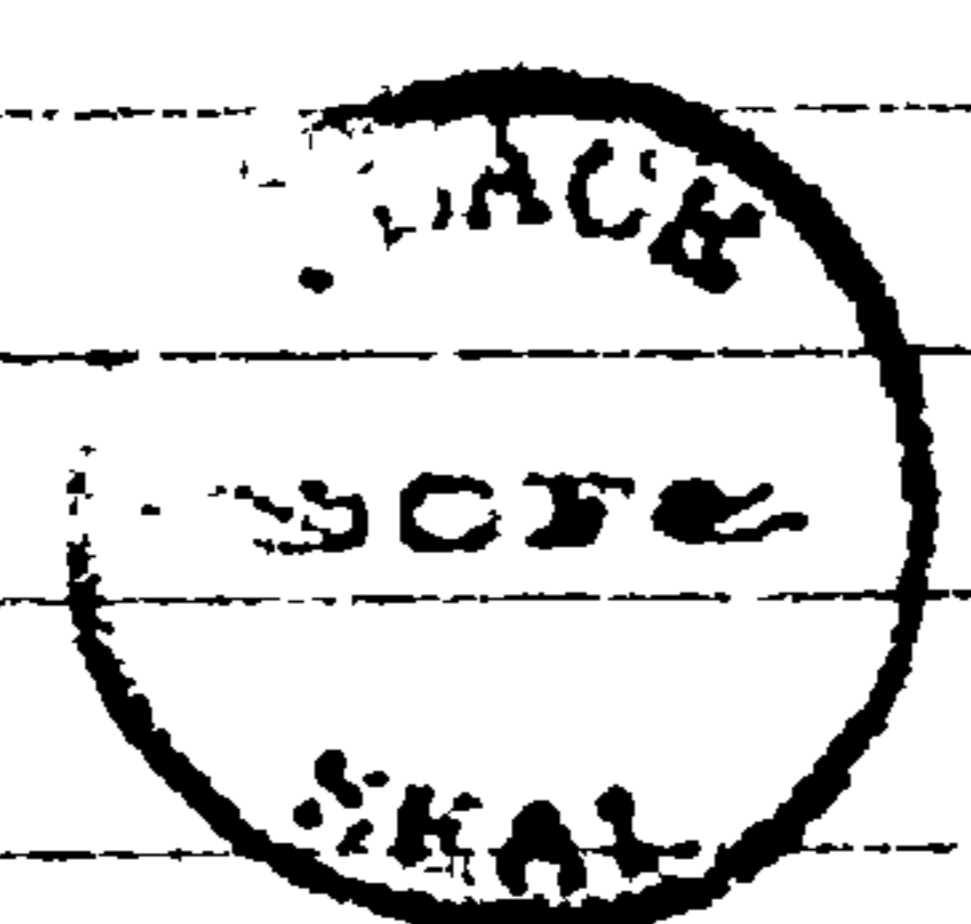

At the request of Robert D. Willian the following deed is received for record and recorded, September 21-1887, at 12.0 O'Clock 40. minutes, P.M.

Text: H. Irving Brown, Clerk:

This deed made this thirtieth day of July in the year 1887, by Joseph B. Brown and Elizava Brown his wife of Frederick County and State of Maryland, Witness that for and in Consideration of the sum of two hundred and Seventy 80/100 Dollars the said Joseph B. Brown and Elizava Brown his wife do grant unto Robert D. Willian of Frederick County and State of Maryland all the following describe tracts of land being part of tract of land conveyed by Charles A. Eyer, being executor of David Harbaugh dec'd lying and being situate in Frederick County, and State of Maryland aforesaid and contained within the following courses and distances, Beginning for said part to be conveyed at a stone planted for a corner by side of Public road, same being a corner of Joel P. Willian's land running thence with Public road N. 66° W. 50.44 perches to stone planted by side of stone fence, then with land Joel P. Willian
