Mullinix, both infant defendants and residents of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding them and each of them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some certain day to be named therein, to answer the premises and to abide by and perform such decree as may be passed therein.

At the request of Leonard C. Mullinix the following deed is recorded April 24, 1878.

This deed made this twentieth third day of April in the year eighteen hundred and seventy eight, by us, William T. Helen and Sarah R. Helen, his wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, witnesseth, that in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred Dollars, we the said William T. Helen and Sarah R. Helen his wife do grant in fee simple unto Leonard C. Mullinix of said County and State, all of those or portions of ground, situate lying and being near Zion Church, in the town or village of Urbana, in the County of Frederick and State of Maryland, known and designated on the plat of said town, made by John Fessler in April, as lots No. 9, and 10, and described as follows: Beginning for said lot No. 9 at a stone planted at the end of the second line of lot No. 5, on the south side of the street and running and bounding on said street, south sixty and one half degrees west ten and a half perches to a stone planted south thirty degrees east, seven and one quarter perches to a stone planted on the alley; and with said alley, north sixty and a half degrees east ten and a half perches to a stone then north twenty nine and a half degrees west, seven and a half perches to the beginning.

And beginning for lot No. 10, at the end of the first line, of lot No. 9, on the south side of the street and running and bounding on said street, south sixty and a half degrees, west, ten and a
