I give and bequeath to my daughter Sybelle M. Edhison, wife of Marshall E. Edhison, the sum of two thousand dollars. I give and bequeath to my son Lorenzo E. Mullinix, the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars. I give and bequeath to my daughter Frances Alberta Mullinix the sum of two thousand dollars. I also give and bequeath to my daughter Frances Alberta Mullinix the Piano and stool and also the cover. I also give and bequeath to my daughter Alberta Mullinix all the silver ware I have, both solid and plated. I also give and bequeath to my daughter Frances Alberta Mullinix one chamber suit of my furniture with bed and clothing for one bed for the same. I also give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my estate to my son Elisha E. Mullinix, my daughter Sybelle M. Edhison, my son Lorenzo E. Mullinix, and my daughter Frances Alberta Mullinix to be divided among them share and share alike, and lastly I constitute my son Lorenzo E. Mullinix, executor of this my last will and Testament with full power to execute all the provisions of this my will, and to sell all real estate that I may have, excepting that which I have devised in this my will, hereby revoking all former wills by me made.
