DECREE

Mary Mullinix, widow, Mary S. Hedges, and Frank H. Hedges, her husband and Eldridge C. Mullinix and Lucy Mullinix his wife et al. } In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity
March Term, 1910.

The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the bill, answer, exhibits nos. 1, 2, and 3, and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is thereupon, this 26th of April in the ^{year} nineteen hundred and ten by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court, adjudged, ordered, and decreed that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold, and that H. Torsey Etchison of Frederick County, Md. and he is hereby appointed Trustee to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of his proceedings shall be as follows: He shall first file in the Clerk's office of this Court, a bond to the State of Maryland, executed by him with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of four thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in him by this decree, or which may be reposed in him by any future order or decree
