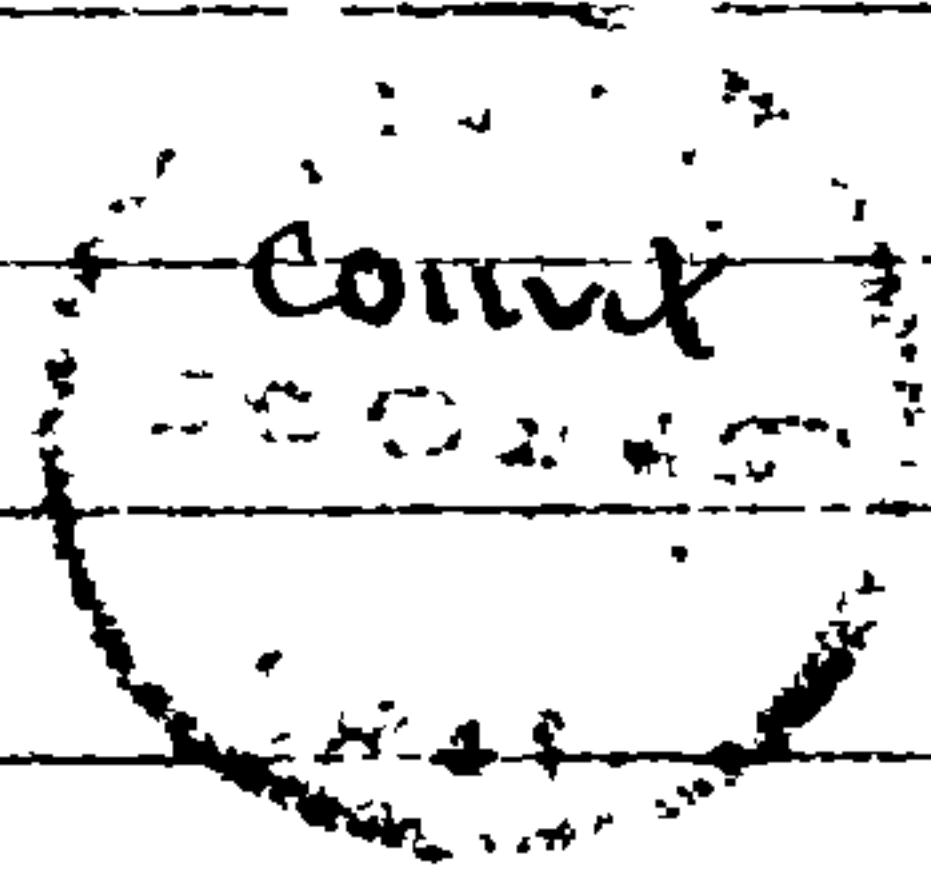

At the request of Joseph W. Caver the following deed is received for record and recorded April 6th 1891, at 10 1/2 O'clock A.M.

This deed made this 3rd day of April in the year eighteen hundred and ninety one by George Zeangfeller and Emma S. Zeangfeller his wife, of Frederick County, Maryland, Witnesses: that in consideration of the sum of Twenty Seven hundred dollars the said George Zeangfeller and Emma S. Zeangfeller, his wife, hereby grant and convey in fee simple to Joseph W. Caver of said County and State, all that lot of Ground with the buildings and improvements thereon, lying being in Frederick City, in the County and State aforesaid, situated on the South Side of West Patrick Street and on the West Side of an alley commonly called Jerry's Alley, at the intersection of said alley and said West Patrick Street in said Frederick City, and being the same property which was conveyed to the said George Zeangfeller by Edward S. Colbantz and wife by deed dated March 20, 1888 and recorded in Liber W.S.P. No. 6, folio 86 one of the Land Records of Frederick County and also being the same real estate which was conveyed to the said Edward S. Colbantz by deed from E. Jane Fortbaugh, Clara S. Smith formerly Clara S. Fortbaugh and John F. Smith dated March 24th, 1884, and recorded in Liber A.D. No. 9, folio 63, one of the Land Records of Frederick County as by reference thereto will more fully appear.
