In pursuance of the annexed order of the Court and notice given me by the Solicitor for the Plaintiffs in the above entitled cause, I Clayton O. Keedy one of the Standing Examiners of said Court duly appointed Qualified and Sworn, having assigned the 12th day of September 1911, at the Office of Jacob Rohrbach in Frederick City as the time and place for taking the testimony in this cause, and having given due notice thereof to the parties concerned did at the appointed time and place proceed to take the following testimony to-wit:-

The Plaintiffs filed with the Examiner as evidence Exhibit "A" & "C" which are herewith returned by the said Examiner.

Mrs. Josephine F. Abrecht, a witness of lawful age produced on the part of the Plaintiffs being duly sworn and examined viva voce, deposes and says as follows:-

My name is Josephine F. Abrecht, my age is 54 years. I reside in Frederick Md. and know the parties to this suit. I am the Plaintiff. I am the widow of Miles A. Abrecht. My husband died and left a will of which "A" filed in this case and now shown me a certified copy. Among other pieces of real estate devised to me in his last will and testament is a lot of ground situated on the North Side of West Patrick Street in Frederick City, Md. and which is fully described in "Exhibit B" filed in this case, and which is described under said will I have sold and agreed to convey to the defendants in this case under a Contract dated Feb. 6, 1911, which is filed in this case as "Exhibit C" This real estate is the same which belonged to William Abrecht or Ebrecht the father of said Miles A. Abrecht. William Abrecht obtained this property by two deeds dated respectively June 23rd 1853, and May 27th 1861, and executed by Joseph Knox, administrator and by
