Wherefore your Orator prays for the following relief:—

That your Honors will pass a decree of your Honorable Court appointing a suitable person as trustee to sell the real estate described in Exhibit A, and divide the net proceeds of said sale among the parties entitled thereto as your Honors may order and direct.

Y., of the object and substance of this bill, and warning them and each of them to appear in this Court in person, or by Solicitor, on or before a certain day therein named to show cause if
