This deed made this twenty fifth day of February in the year Eighteen hundred and eighty one, by Alexis E. Smith of Frederick County in the State of Maryland Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of six hundred dollars \$ the said Alexis E. Smith do grant unto Andrew Jackson Jones of the County and State aforesaid all that part or parcel of ground with the buildings and improvements thereon consisting of the Eastern part or half of the lot of ground with the buildings and improvements thereof consisting of the Eastern part or half of the lot of ground with the buildings and improvements thereon situate and lying on the South Side of West All Saint Street in Frederick City, Frederick County and State of Maryland the same being part of lot No. 4 fronting on said Street 15 1/2 feet and with a depth of 189 feet more or less and being the Eastern part or half as above described of the lot of ground described in a deed from William S. Fantz and Caroline Fantz his wife, to the said Alexis E. Smith, dated the eighth day of December in the year 1858, and recorded in Liber F. G. F. No. 3, folio 607, C. One of the said Records of Frederick County as by reference thereto will appear.

The words "fronting on said Street 15 1/2 feet and with a depth of 189 feet more or less" on the sixteenth line of this instrument of writing, were interlined before the execution of this deed.
