The Object of this Bill is to obtain a Decree for the Sale of the real estate of Andrew Jones, late of Frederick County deceased.

The Bill in substance states that Andrew J. Jones, late of Frederick County died on or about the — day of — A.D. 1897, intestate, leaving surviving him, a widow America Jones, and the following named children and heirs at Law, viz: William H. Jones, Mary E. Jones, Martha E. Thomas, Wife of John Thomas, Annie Nelson, Wife of George Nelson, Bertha Myers Wife of Alexander — Myers, and Charles M. Jones.

That the said Andrew J. Jones, was, at the time of his death seized and possessed of a house and lot of ground, situated on the South Side of West All Saints Street, in Frederick County, Maryland, described in a deed from Alexious E. Smith to Andrew J. Jones, dated April 26th, A.D. 1881, and recorded in Liber A. T. No. 2, folio 747, one of the said Records for Frederick County, Maryland. That since the death of the said Andrew J. Jones, his widow, America Jones, has died, and Martha E. Thomas, a daughter of the said Martha E. Thomas, and Annie Nelson, a daughter of the said Andrew J.
