Samuel Ashby, her husband, and George Nelson, and Martha Myers and Alexander Myers her husband, two adults, residing in Baltimore, Maryland, and that Carrie Thomas and Mary E Thomas and Annie Thomas are infants and reside in Baltimore Maryland. The Bill then prays that a Trustee may be appointed by a Decree of the Court, who shall sell said real estate and divide the proceeds among the parties hereto entitled.

(Two successive Subpoenas issued in this case against the defendants John Thomas and George Nelson adults, and Carrie Thomas an infant, have been returned non-suit, and their present whereabouts are unknown to the Plaintiff, and said defendants may be proceeded against as if they were non-residents.)

It is thereupon this 7th day of December 1910. Ordered that the said Plaintiff, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper published in Frederick County once a week for four successive weeks, prior to the 7th day of January 1911, give notice to said defendants, John Thomas, George Nelson, and Carrie Thomas, of the object and substance of this Bill filed in this case, and naming them and each of them to be and appear in this Court in person or by solicitor on or before the 23rd day of January 1911, to answer the premises and to show cause, if any they have, why a decree should not be passed as prayed.
