This Mortgage made this 31st day of December, in Eighteen  
hundred and eighty two by Harriet J. Gloyd and George W.  
Gloyd her husband Adam Kaylor and Mary E. Kaylor his  
Wife of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland.

Witnesseth, That whereas the the Said Harriet J. Gloyd and  
George W. Gloyd her husband and Adam Kaylor and Mary  
E. Kaylor his Wife have Stand indebted to the Savings Bank  
of Brunswick a body Corporate of the State of Maryland  
in Frederick County in the Sum of Twelve Hundred and  
fifty Dollars (\$1250.00) upon their promissory note of even date  
herewith payable to the Said Savings Bank of Brunswick or  
order six months after date and for the better Securing the  
payment of the Said promissory note or of any  
other Note or Notes that may from time to time be given  
hereafter in payment of the Same or any part thereof the  
the Said Harriet J. Gloyd and George W. Gloyd her hus-  
band and Adam Kaylor and Mary E. Kaylor his Wife  
have agreed to execute these presents.

Now therefore in Consideration of the premises and of  
the Sum of one dollar paid by the Said Savings Bank of  
Brunswick to the Said Harriet J. Gloyd and George W. Gloyd her  
husband and Adam Kaylor and Mary E. Kaylor his Wife the  
receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the Said Harriet  
J. Gloyd and George W. Gloyd her husband and Adam Kaylor  
and Mary E. Kaylor his Wife do grant in fee simple to the  
Said Savings Bank of Brunswick all the following described  
pieces and parcels of land situate lying and being in Frederick  
County, State of Maryland described as follows: To wit  
that lot or parcel of land situate lying and being in the  
Town of Brunswick in Said County and State and known  
as lot No. 4 & Block No. 10, as shown on the plat of the  
Real Estate and Improvement Company's Subdivision of  
part of Brunswick prepared by R. T. Martin, Surveyor, and date  
July 24th, 1890, and recorded with the deed from the Real Estate  
and Improvement Company of Baltimore City to Charles F. Ernest  
dated April 2nd, 1891, and recorded prior hereto among the  
Land Records of Frederick County, said plat being herewith  
made part of the description, and being the same property here-  
before conveyed to Harriet J. Gloyd and Adam Kaylor by William S.  
Grass et al by deed dated Oct. 18th 1892 and recorded in Liber J. S.  
J. No. 3. folio 271. One of the Land Records of Frederick County  
with all improvements thereon and thereto belonging.

Provided that if the Said Harriet J. Gloyd and George W.  
Gloyd her husband and Adam Kaylor and Mary E. Kaylor
