This deed made this 15th day of March in the year eighteen hundred and ninety three by us Benjamin Albert Thrasher and William Johnson Thrasher and Ella Virginia Thrasher his wife all of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Witnesses that in consideration of the sum of one thousand (\$1000.00) Dollars we the said Benjamin Albert Thrasher and William Johnson Thrasher, and Ella Virginia Thrasher his wife do hereby grant unto Thomas S. Thrasher all of our undivided right, title and interest, being two undivided one third parts, in and to all those pieces and parcels of land, Situate in Frederick County,

State of Maryland, being part of a tract of land called "Cut Knee" and part of a tract of land called "Halders" Manor, containing in the aggregate one hundred and forty nine acres three rods and six square perches of land, and being the same land heretofore conveyed by Sarah M. Kessler, Executrix of the last will of Israel Kessler, deceased to said Thomas S. Thrasher by deed dated on the 17th day of October in the year Eighteen hundred and eight.
