Final Decree

Filed Oct 26 1906.

The Bill of Complaint, Answers, Testimony, and all the other proceedings in the above entitled Cause having been read and well considered, and the same having been submitted for final decree, it is thereupon on this 24th day of October, in the year nineteen hundred and six, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, sitting as a Court of Equity, and by the authority thereof, adjudged, ordered and decreed that the Defendant Corporation, Builders Supply Company, is insolvent, and that Walter J. Johnston and Jacob Rohrbach, the Receivers heretofore appointed by this Court, in this Cause, at once proceed to liquidate the affairs of the said Corporation in accordance with the terms and requirements of the order of this Court heretofore passed in this Cause on the date April 27th, in the year 1906; the ultimate object of this Decree being that the property and assets shall be equitably distributed among the creditors of the said Defendant.

And it is further decreed, that the said Receivers give notice for at least twenty days by public advertisement in one of the newspapers published in Frederick City, Maryland, to all the creditors of the said Defendant Corporation to file their claims in this Cause with the Clerk of this Court.
