feet to the lot of ground conveyed by said Thomas J. Cannon to J. Harris Cannon by deed dated April 21st 1902, and recorded among the land records of Baltimore City in Silver R. O. No. 2456, folio 268 A. Thence South on the line of the lot of ground so conveyed as above to the North Side of Mulberry Street and thence West on Mulberry Street to the beginning. Which said lot of ground said Thomas J. Cannon acquired in fee by deed from Louis Ficker and Wife dated April 24th 1891, recorded among the land records aforesaid in Silver R. O. No. 1897, folio 111 which deed is herewith filed marked "Complainant's Exhibit No. 1." This lot of ground was described in above mentioned deed to J. Harris Cannon being a portion of the whole ground conveyed by the said deed herewith filed. Said lot of ground hereinabove described, and being the portion of said whole lot described in and conveyed by said deed from Ficker and which said Thomas J. Cannon died seized and possessed, being improved by a three story dwelling house as No. 401 North Tuller Avenue.

(2.) A certain lot of ground in the City of Baltimore beginning on the East Side of Entaw Street 583 feet northerly from Madison Street and running thence Northwesterly on Entaw Street 20 feet thence easterly at right angles with Entaw Street 100 feet to the West Side of Linden Avenue thence Southwesterly on Linden Avenue 20 feet and thence Westwesterly by a straight line 140 feet to the place of beginning. Which said lot of ground the said Thomas J. Cannon acquired in fee by deed from Robert T. Kammor et al. dated September 27th 1894, recorded among the land records aforesaid in Silver R. O. No. 1806, folio 506, B, which said deed is herewith filed marked "Complainant's Exhibit No. 2." Said lot of ground being improved by a three story dwelling on the Entaw Street front thereof known as No. 849 North Entaw Street (sometimes known as Hamilton Terrace), and a store and dwelling on the Linden Avenue front known as No. Linden Avenue.

(3.) All these pieces or parcels of ground situate and lying in the first Election District of Baltimore County, in this State on or near the Johns Cate Road, of which the said Thomas J. Cannon died seized and possessed consisting in part of the following lots or parcels of ground it being intended to include in these proceedings all the land so situate in Baltimore County belonging to said Thomas J. Cannon at the time of his death a fuller and more accurate description of which will be hereafter filed, if necessary viz:
