4. Q. Did he die testate or intestate.

A. He left a will (Certified copy of will in question marked "Exhibit No. 1" filed with the court)

5. Q. Did he leave a widow surviving, and if so, what was her name?

A. He left a widow: her name was Anna M. S. Mavalley

6. Q. Is she living or dead.

7. Q. Did said Wilhelm or William Adam leave any children surviving him?

A. Yes, Sir.

8. Q. Give their names and the names of the husbands or wives of those who are married.

A. Well, I can Mavalley give them to you in rotation. There was John K. and William H. These are the two boys they are both single. Mary E. Married Henry Brechtling. She is now a widow. Catherine E. Taut - she is also a widow. Annie E. Married a man named Carter, Emma Hanson, her husband's name is Frank, Clara E. Gavis - her husband's name is Charles E. Gavis.

9. Q. Are these children all adults?

A. Yes, Sir.

10. Q. Where do they reside?

A. Well the boys reside in Frederick, and most of the girls except Annie - I think - four of the girls live in Baltimore.

11. Q. Did said Wilhelm or William Adam leave any real estate situated in Frederick City?

A. Yes, Sir.

12. Q. Describe the same and state where it is situated?

A. It is situated on West Patrick Street, near the Bridge: a three story brick house east of the bridge, about six or seven doors the side of the bridge opposite the Gem Laundry.

13. Q. Look at the paper now shown you, marked "Exhibit No. 2" being a deed from Valerius Ebert, Trustee to said William Adam, and state whether or not the property therein described is that of which said William Adam died seized and possessed.
