

3d line North eighty one degrees. West twenty two and four tenth perches to a Marble Stone at the end of said 3d line, then South ten degrees East one hundred and thirty eight perches to a Marble Stone planted in the end of the 4th line aforesaid, then with said line reversed, South seventy four and one Quarter degrees. East twenty three and three fourths perches to the place of beginning, Containing eighteen acres, one rood and thirty perches of land more or less. Also part of a lot No. 13 part of said tract, called "Araby" beginning for the same at the beginning of the whole lot No. 13, and running thence by and with the closing line thereof reversed, North seventy four and one Quarter degrees. West forty three perches. Still with said lot reversed, North six and one Quarter degrees West two perches, then running parallel with the first line two perches from the same, South seventy four and one Quarter degrees. East until it intersects the first line of the aforesaid lot No. 13, then with said first line reversed to the place of beginning, Containing two roods and six perches of land more or less. Also a lot or parcel of land, not designated by name but adjoining the aforesaid tract, commencing for the outline at a stone planted near the farm belonging to Francis M. Myers, and running West with said Myers line to a stone planted where the said line joins the land of Jacob Lewis, then South with said line to a creek, then East with said creek to a stone planted at the corner of Josiah's Saints lot, in the road, then with said road, North to the place of beginning, Containing five acres of land more or less. All of said tracts containing in the aggregate, One hundred and twenty seven acres of land more or less, and being the same land heretofore conveyed to the said Ann E Specht by Francis M. Myers and wife by deed dated on the fourth day of July in the year 1880, and recorded in Liber C. F. No. 5, folio 368, to one of the Land Records of Frederick County.
