To the Honorable: The Judges of Said Court:-

The Bill of Complaint of Cora May Miller, Frank A. Miller, Annie B. Eyles and Mealy Eyles her husband and George M. Miller and Maudie Miller his wife, respectively shows unto your Honors:-

1st. That a certain Margaret E Miller late of Frederick County, Maryland was in her lifetime and at the time of her death in or about the month of May A.D. 1884, seized and possessed of a certain tract or parcel of land containing about one hundred and thirty two acres of land more or less situate being and being partly in Frederick County and partly in Carroll County in the State of Maryland, which the said Margaret E Miller obtained from her father, Frederick Fively by deed dated the first day of May A.D. 1874, and which said deed was duly recorded on the 22nd day of April, A.D. 1909, in Liber & P.M. No. 286, folio 281, et seq, one of the land Records of Frederick County, and which said deed was also duly recorded, on April 29-1909, in Liber D.P.S. No. 11, folio 402, one of the said Records of Carroll County, Maryland, except all that portion of said tract or parcel of land which was conveyed to Michael Kretzer by John Carnack, by deed dated April 20th A.D. 1863, and except that portion of said tract or parcel of land which was conveyed to Jacob Fively by the said Margaret Miller and George D. Miller her husband, the excepted parts or parcels of land of the whole tract aggregating ten acres of land. The said deed from Frederick Fively to the said Margaret E Miller, and George D. Miller her husband, the excepted parts or parcels of land, the said deed from Frederick Fively to the said Margaret E Miller being herewith filed and marked Exhibit "M. E. M.", which said Exhibit together with all other Exhibits herewith filed it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill of Complaint. The said deed from Margaret E Miller and George D. Miller her husband to Jacob Fively being herewith filed and marked Exhibit "J. B."
