1899. March 6. Jury returned by Sheriff unpanelled and sworn and same day Inquisition found returned & filed, finding "That said Ella S. Miller is now a lunatic and insane pauper at Frederick County aforesaid" 1899 March 6. Courts Order filed verifying & Confirming Inquisition and further ordered "That the said Ella S. Miller be confined in the Almshouse of Frederick County at the expense of said County until she shall have recovered her reason and been discharged therefrom by the course of law.
